OLD BUSINESS: Sue Kennedy stated that the By-Laws were changed in November so that we can have a 50/50 drawing at the National, legally.

2021 NATIONAL REPORT:

Much discussion was held regarding this. **Sue Kennedy** has been working on lining up food trucks, golf carts, etc.

Joe Bacon wants to make clear that anyone helping at the international meet must register and pay for any event that has a fee attached. It is \$15.00 per collector car (IF you are registered). The registration fee is \$40.00 (early register) \$50.00 for later registration. That amount allows up to 4 people

in but their names should be sent in with the application so a name tag can be made for them. **Marvin Snider** reported that we have two buildings for vendors. One holds 60 booths and one holds 48 booths. The 60 booth building is already sold out and the 48 booth building is almost full (30 booths). No outdoor vendors yet. **Danny Taylor** is rounding up buses for different events.



Nancy Bacon mentioned that she had talked to Darlene Williams recently and that she is doing well. She was supposed to be Joe's assistant before she became ill. Larry Kennedy has taken that position.



2021 SDC International Meet Update

We are eight months away from the 2021 International meet and interest in the meet is accelerating by the day. The host hotel is now full and other hotels are filling fast. The swap meet buildings are also filling at a steady pace. The next issue of *Turning Wheels* will have the registration form for meet attendance, a copy is also included in this newsletter on page 6.

Two points to remember here:

- 1. Everyone working or attending the meet MUST be a current member of the Studebaker Drivers Club Inc. and registered for the meet.
- 2. Early Bird Registration is \$40.00 and ends on 3/31/2021, this will save members \$10.00 from the regular rate (\$50.00) and a late fee of \$60.00 for those registering after 8/01/2021.

Larry and Sue Kennedy have been working on food vendors, for the ice cream social as well as the farewell dinner. This has been a slow process with today's Covid situation but we have made progress, the cafeteria in the Market Place building will be open the entire meet. This vendor also owns an ice cream truck as well and he will serve the ice cream social on Tuesday evening to open the meet. We have a preferred vendor for the farewell dinner but are waiting on them to confirm, they are under contract with the Indianapolis Motor Speedway and there could be a conflict. We have a couple other options if needed.

Friday evening the Indy Chapter will be hosting a "Street Dance" along with a variety of food trucks. The disc jockey has been acquired and in March we should be able to book a few food trucks.

Bob Palma was a great help in contacting potential speakers, we have a preliminary meet schedule built and each day has a full slate of activities for our guests. Jeff Westcott as well as Dave Arland have been working on activities at the Indianapolis Motor Speedway. The Speedway Museum is now opened and Jeff will be contacting them soon. It appears the track is booked for the week by Porsche, but that is not final at this time. We will keep trying and update as much as possible.

Danny Taylor has researched and prepared several free self-driving tours as well as a couple of bus tours that will have a fee. Danny is also getting quotes for the bus transportation. Sometime in late spring we should have tours finalized and submitted to *Turning Wheels*.

The model car show planned for Saturday is moving along as well as the "Brand X" car show. The car show is being handled by the Southern Indiana Hudson car club. More details to follow on those events.

What are we missing? If you have not volunteered to help please do so now, we can always use more help. You can reach any of the committee people, their contact info is also included in this newsletter on page 5. Hopefully with the vaccinations we can soon get back to normal meeting both chapter wise and the SDC International meet.


